• It is the patient's responsibility to notify our office 24-hours prior to your scheduled appointment if you are unable to keep your appointment. Failure to do so will result in a \$25.00 no show/cancellation fee. Initial
• It is the client's responsibility to participate as fully as possible in the therapeutic process and activities. Initial
